Digital Information, Hardware and Software (25 marks)

1. Name three examples of input devices that can be connected to a computer.

Keyboard, mouse, game controller, joystick, touch pad, tablet, scanner, bar code reader

2. What does "copyright" mean?

Copyright is a set of exclusive legal rights regarding the use of information. Typically, the information may not be legally used, modified or copied without the permission of the owner of the copyright. Copyright does not protect ideas. It is usually for a limited duration (lifetime of the author plus either 50 or 70 years).

3. Give a simple rule with which you can protect yourself against spyware, malware and viruses.

Don't run any executable programs that you don't trust. Don't open email attachments unless you know who has sent them (and trust that they are reliable). Use anti-virus software to scan email attachments and files before you open them.

4. What is the difference between analogue and digital information?

Analogue information is continuous. It has theoretically infinite resolution, which means that small variations are meaningful.

Digital information is discrete, and normally represents numbers, letters or other symbols. Digital information often has limited precision, the limit depends on the number of discrete values that are stored. Digital information in a computer is normally stored using binary.

A command line interface is a way of interacting with software that uses text-only input to a command line. This is generally more powerful than a graphical interface, but more difficult to use since the user must remember all the commands. An example of an OS that uses a CLI is MS-DOS.

A graphical user interface is a way of interacting with software that uses graphical elements such as windows, icons and menus. The user typically manipulates the elements using a device such as a mouse to control a pointer. This is generally easier to use than a command line interface. An example of an OS that uses a GUI is Windows XP.

Presentation (10 marks)

24. Some PowerPoint presentations use animation to ensure that only one point is shown at a time. State one advantage of this approach and one disadvantage.

(i) Advantage

The audience remains focused on a single point at a time. This keeps the audience together (concentrating on the same thing at the same time).

(2 marks)

(ii) Disadvantage

Because the audience can see only a single point, they can't anticipate what it coming up. This sometimes makes it more difficult for people to put the points into context and to see the bigger picture.

25. Give one piece of advice about the use of colour that applies to both PowerPoint presentations and web site design.

Make sure that the colours used for the foreground text have high contrast against the background so that the text is easy to see. Use a limited range of colours - too many will make the page appear "busy" and confusing. Ensure that the background colour does not dominate the presentation and overpower the information. If you are using colours to signify meaning, be aware that colour-blind viewers may not be able to distinguish between certain colours (such as red/green and blue/yellow).

26. What advice would you give about the design of navigation features on a web page within a given web site?

Navigation features should be obvious to a reader. They should have a consistent appearance and location for all pages within the site. The navigation structure should be simple and easy to use. Any page should be able to be reached from any other page within the site by following a maximum of three links between them.

A language used to describe how pages look. It is used by laser printers.

29. Given a black and white bitmap image that is 20 pixels wide and 40 pixels high, how many **bytes** of memory are required to store the image (ignore the memory required for header information)? Show your working.

20 x 40 = 800 pixels
black and white means 1 bit used for each pixel
so 800 bits required
since there are 8 bits for each byte
800 bits = 100 bytes
