- Bob Gaskins
- Released 1987 for the Macintosh
- Bought by Microsoft in 1987

Office Suite

- PowerPoint
- Word
- Excel

PowerPoint today

Standard presentation tool

- Widely used
- Widely accepted

Some problems

- Poor compatibility
- Criticism

Criticisms

Edward Tufte

- PowerPoint is evil
- PowerPoint *constrains* the presenter
- Ideas forced to fit PowerPoint limits
- Tables / Data forced to fit PowerPoint
- Poor presentations

"Death by PowerPoint"

Poor presentations that use PowerPoint

- Reading from the slides
- Poorly designed slides

- Heading
- Content
- Footer

Content


Content organized into hierarchy

- Uses bullet points
- Five possible levels in hierarchy

Top level

- Second level
 - Third level
 - *Fouth level*
 - » Fifth level


Slide Layout




Layout

Standard layouts provided

- Allows content to be displayed using different designs
- Examples
 - Two-column text
 - Text and pictures
 - Multiple pictures



Layout Example




Slide Design

Design Template

- Background
- Colour scheme
- Font style
- Size and location of content boxes

Design your own template

Master Slides

- Define the style used for all slides in presentation
- View → Master → Slide Master

Background

- Format → Background
- Fill with Simple colour, Gradient, Pattern, Picture

Slide Transitions

Animation as one slide replaced by the next

- Slide Show → Slide Transition
- Style
- Sound
- Speed

Animation Schemes

Slideshow → Animation Schemes

- Apply to entire slide
- Main heading animated using scheme
- Content uses more subtle animation

Adding Animation

Slide Show → Custom Animation


- Apply to any element on the slide
 - Text, Picture, Drawing
- Add Effect: Entry, Emphasis, Movement, Exit
- Set condition to trigger animation
- Speed and timing
- Repetition

Example of repeated animation

Animation: Starting Conditions

When the animation starts

- Start on click
- Start with previous
- Start after previous



Animation: Entrance


Entry animations used to animate the appearance of an object

- Many different styles of animation used
- Divided into broad categories
 - Basic
 - Subtle
 - Moderate
 - Exciting

Animation: Motion

Text / Object Motion

- Define a path that the object follows when animated
- Choose a predefined path or define your own



Animation: Exit

Exit animations used to animate the disappearance of an object

- Similar to the Entry animations
- Divided into broad categories
 - Basic
 - Subtle
 - Moderate
 - Exciting

Animation: Effect Options

Right-click on animation effect in Custom Animation

- Choose Effect Options
- Examine the available options

Very Slow	Very Slow	Very Slow
Emphasis Spin Effect Option: All at once	Emphasis Spin Effect Option: By Word	Emphasis Spin Effect Option: By Letter
Very Fast	Very Fast	Very Fast
