## **Topic:** The Shepard Tone of Information Security

Irrespective of whether you call it "Cyber" or "Information Security", we've all found ourselves in an industry that expands and evolves at an eye watering pace. This means the volume of information to learn can be both exciting and intimidating for those just entering the industry, but those of us who have been around a little longer should also think the exact same thing. New Zealand always punches above its weight in terms of innovation; this means opportunities for information security professionals are now opening up into industries previously not considered possible.
