




Navigation ▶ Users have trouble navigating in many web sites Navigation should be easy - three click-rule ▶ Navigation bar on the left is common ▶ Navigation bar on the right is more ergonomic ▶ Each page should ▶ Tell the user what the page is about ▶ Clearly identify how to get to other pages (Obvious links) ▶ Familiarity Use layout and design that people are familiar with
